Hurricane Preparation Guide:

START WITH A HURRICANE SUPPLY KIT:

Flashlights, battery-operated radio, battery-operated lanterns, batteries (different sizes), matches, first aid kit, duct tape, rain gear, clock (wind-up or battery-powered), plastic garbage bags, fire extinguisher, scissors, manual can opener, clean clothes, extra blankets and pillows, heavy work gloves, to name a few.

FOOD & WATER:

- Bottled water (1 gallon/person/day)
- Bottled Juice
- Two coolers (one for drinks, one for food)
- Canned foods / bread
- Paper plates, paper/plastic cold drink cups, plastic forks, spoons and knives
- Manual can opener
- Dry pet food / any pet medications

MEDICAL NEEDS:

Medic-alert tags, insect-repellent sprays, sunscreen, soap, first aid kit, two (2) week supply of prescription/over the counter medication (adult/children), bandages.

HOME:

Remove outdoor items such as yard art and decorations. Trim dead branches from trees, board up windows, fill gas tanks and extras containers, get extra cash, move furniture away from windows, store important documents in waterproof containers. Take pictures of your contents before hurricane hits.

FILING INSURANCE CLAIMS:

Although your first concern should be safety, it is important to be aware of the need to act promptly when filing claims for damages inflicted to your property by a hurricane. Take video of property, inside/outside, have your policy number available, contact your insurance company asap, make list of damages, if possible document damage with photos/video.

MAKE FAMILY COMMUNICATION PLAN:

Have a family/friend plan to know how to communicate with one another. Make sure cell phones are fully charged.
