Spectrum Service Change:

Spectrum has announced that beginning in July any cable subscriber who doesn't have a cable box will not be able to receive the basic channels.

If you don't have a cable box you will need to get one. In the fall of 2017, the Board of Directors negotiated a free cable box as part of renewing our contract. Normally there is a monthly charge for the use of their cable box equipment.

Some residents who have taken advantage of the free cable box have reported that there was an additional charge associated with the box. The additional cost was most likely due to the price for the type of package chosen.

Spectrum offers four (4) TV packages:

- 1. Select This is the new basic package
- 2. Silver (plus Select)
- 3. Gold (plus Select and Silver)
- 4. MI Plan Latino (Spectrum Basic + Latino Channels)

All four (4) packages have a cost attached to them. You can obtain a free cable box by going to a Spectrum outlet or have one delivered to your door by calling 855-222-0102.

I posted a copy of the different plans Spectrum offers on the office bulletin board. Remember, you get a free box, but the service may be an additional charge. I already have two (2) cables boxes but wanted a third one for the bedroom. I saved \$21.45 per month by downgrading to the Select package. If I didn't change my package I would have received an approximate \$4.00 per month increase.

On a good note:

Residents who presently use Spectrum as their internet provider will get an increased access speed. The internet speed will increase from 25 megabits to 100 megabits per second.

This will happen once you choose the type of Spectrum package that suits your needs.
